Two additional governors-elect will serve new two-year terms after multiple-year absences from the Television Academy’s governing body: Eva Basler (Daytime Programming) and Kate Linder (Performers).

In accordance with the renaming of the Interactive Media Peer Group as the Emerging Media Programming Peer Group, with new membership requirements effective Jan. 1, 2023, elections for that Peer Group will take place Dec. 5 - 19, 2022.
